Muster Roll of the Field and Staff Officers of Cavalry under the command of Major General Amos Hall, commanded by Lieut. Col. Seymour Boughton from the 23 day of December 1813 to the 21 day of January 1814, ordered out by Maj. Gen. A. Hall. Called into service on the Niagara Frontier by order of Maj. Genl Hall from 23 Dec 1813 to 21 January 1814.

Payments totaled \$371.61 due from State of NY to Lt. Col. Seymour Boughton Field & Staff.
